

# SWAN STUDIO DANCE BALLET UNIFORM NOTICE

## Dear Parents:

Dance Uniforms for Swan Studio Dance are as follows:

### **Dance Readiness & Pre-Primary Ballet:**

- White
- Short-sleeve cotton body suit
- White dotted chiffon skirt
- No shoes or socks
- During colder weather, students may wear a solid white sweatshirt or cardigan

### **Primary, Grade One & Grade Two:**

- Pink
- Sleeveless cotton with elastic waistband
- Pink ankle socks
- Pink, full-sole leather ballet slippers (Blochs)
- *Primary students may wear their pre-primary suit until such time as it no longer fits and then acquire the required pink uniform*

### **Grade Three, Grade Four, & Grade Six:**

- Royal Blue
- Cotton sleeveless bodysuit
- Cotton tights with hole in foot
- Bloch ballet slippers

### **Pre-Elementary and Up:**

- Black
- Thin-strapped cotton bodysuit
- Cotton tights with hole in foot

### **Please Note:**

*All waistbands must be tightened and on skirts to ensure a snug fit at the waist.*

*Grades One and Up will be required to purchase a black canvas character shoe by no later than October 31.*

*Please be advised that Swan Studio Dance uniforms are available at the London Dance Shoppe. Please label all clothing and dance attire with the dancer's name.*

*Please have students arrive with their dance material in a zippered dance bag to help control space management and avoid confusion and loss.*

### **Hair, Jewelry Etc.:**

- All students must have their hair in a ballet bun (where possible). Please use bobby pins and hairnets. Scrunchies may be used to decorate the hair.
- NO JEWELRY. Swan Studio Dance is not responsible for lost or stolen valuables. Small studded earrings are permissible where required (i.e. – newly-pierced ears) but not preferred.
- Students must be on time for classes. Attention to punctuality sets a professional, positive and respectful tone for the class and the Studio.
- If high-school aged students do not have the proper attire and hair for class they will not be permitted to enter the classroom. They will be required to exit the class until their hair is appropriate.
- Younger students will stay in the class and teachers will speak with the parents directly.
